Workplace Violence Prevention Program Management:

Development of workplace violence prevention programs including the construction of policies and procedures; creation of crisis management teams; and workplace violence awareness training.

Physical Security Vulnerability Assessments:

Services include conducting detailed assessments of client's facilities covering a wide spectrum of security areas including: access control, CCTV, alarm systems, security staff, mail screening, key control, etc.
